Hair Transplant Pre-Operative Instructions

To ensure that your	surgery day goes smoothly, we ask that you read the following:
1. Preparation	 Wash your hair the night before or the morning of your surgery. Please do not add hair gels, hair products, or any oils to your hair.
2. Breakfast	Eat a meal prior to your arrival.
3. Transportation	 Please arrive at the Surgery Center 15 minutes prior to your appointment time. We recommend organizing transportation home, this allows us to give medications to keep you relaxed during your procedure.
4. Clothing	 Wear a shirt that has buttons or zips down in the front. Do not wear a shirt that fits tightly or must be pulled up over the head, as this may disrupt grafts. You may bring a zip-up sweatshirt or jacket to wear before and after surgery.
5. Lunch	 We provide lunch and snacks; however, you can bring your own if you prefer.
6. Entertainment	 For your entertainment, we offer Music, Netflix and Amazon Prime to watch during your procedure.
Please refrain from tal	king the following medications or vitamins prior to your surgery:
Aspirin, aspirin containing products	1 week prior * Do not discontinue if instructed to take it by your primary care physician. Please consult our providers first.
NSAIDS (Ibuprofen, Excedrin)	1 week prior
Vitamin E, multivitamins	1 week prior
Ginko biloba or other herbal supplements	1 week prior (no more than 400 IU's daily)
Viagra/Cialis	1 day prior

Please refrain from the following prior to surgery:	
Alcohol consumption	5 days prior
Smoking cigarettes or marijuana	1 day prior
Caffeine consumption	1 day prior -If you experience withdrawal headaches, one small cup is allowed.
Strenuous exercise or weightlifting	1 day prior

MDEE patients:

Your suture removal appointment will be scheduled for **8 days** after surgery.

Payment in the form of:

MasterCard, Visa, American Express, Discover, Cashier's Check, Cash, or **financing**: CareCredit, Alpaeon, Lending Club & Allegro is due 14 days prior to the date of your surgery.
