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Q. What is your specialty?

A. Ziering Medical specializes in comprehensive hair loss management and hair transplant procedures for receding hairlines, bald spots, eyebrows, and beard restoration. We are renowned for our expertise in delivering superior surgical hair restoration outcomes using the latest surgical techniques and technology. Our surgeons are highly skilled in both Follicular Unit Excision (FUE) and Microscopically Dissected Elliptical Excision (MDEE), allowing us to tailor the surgical approach to each patient's needs.

Q. What type of procedures do you offer?

A. Every patient is unique, so we design individualized treatment plans that address the specific causes and extent of hair loss, as well as each patient's aesthetic goals. Most plans include a combination of surgical and non-surgical treatment options. Besides hair transplant surgery, we offer a wide range of non-surgical treatments, such as topical solutions like ZMIN, ZFIN, and Z Factors, along with red light therapy using the Z Cap, and Scalp Micropigmentation (SMP). We may also recommend specific lifestyle and nutritional changes as part of the overall treatment plan.

Q. What does your team wish every hair loss patient understood?

A. The most common cause of hair loss is Androgenic Alopecia, or genetic hair loss, a progressive condition where early intervention can significantly improve outcomes. We urge patients to schedule a consultation at the first signs of hair thinning, such as finding more hair in the brush than usual or the shower drain.

Q. What distinguishes Ziering Medical from other hair restoration clinics?

A. Our approach begins with having a world-class team of expert surgeons and technicians. We understand the emotional impact of hair loss and are dedicated to supporting a diverse range of patients. Our mission is to help each patient take a step toward addressing their hair loss. We recognize the importance of post-surgical support and provide 12 months of aftercare for each patient, ensuring optimal results and patient support throughout the hair restoration journey. Unlike other cosmetic procedures, a hair transplant doesn't result in an instant, overnight change. The transplanted hair grows in slowly over time with the mature result being visible between 12 to 14 months for men and 16 to 18 months for women.
